

Kimpton Bench Working Party Report

22/01/20 to 19/02/20

Parish Council

- Filled holes in roadway between Hitch Road and Parkfield Rec car park
- Did copious siding out at Coopers Hill and all the way down the High Street as far as the school, and various side roads
- Mended goal nets on small goals at Recreation Ground
- Removed weeds growing on play bark under play equipment and raked bark
- Removed redundant bus stop outside 108 High Street
- Refurbished and rehung gates to Recreation Ground (ROSPA inspection report) and had bolt repaired (free of charge by Ray Baskerville!)
- Had several bonfires
- Reset Footpath post at top of Lloyd Way
- Mended fence at Peters Green Village Hall
- Removed fallen tree over pavement at Peters Green
- Made and fitted new side panel for steps at Allotment pedestrian entrance, Hall Lane
- Removed fallen tree at Coopers Hill after Storm Ciara
- Reset bench on The Green after Storm Ciara
- Started clearing outside the Football Pavilion of debris, ready for staining. Also cleared gutters.
- Emptied drain at bottom of Church Lane

Memorial Hall

- Fitted new outside lights all around the Hall
- Refitted head to vacuum cleaner

School

- Improved the outdoor willow classroom with extra willow from Hertwood Forest
- Removed ivy from outside wall of girl's toilet
- Made new (lightweight) sandpit cover for Pre-school
- Fitted Blue Kimpton Heritage plaque to school wall
- Cleared car park of weeds and soil

Church

- Lifted heavy reredos through 90 degrees from covering window, found full of woodworm, recommended it be removed from the church. All agree awaiting Diocese approval
- Removed several bags of twigs etc and took to bonfire
- Reset gate at NE of churchyard

- Fitted Blue Kimpton Heritage plaque to wall of Pam's Cottage
