Notes:

- 1. It was noted that Hall Lane entrance gate metal chain is missing. A replacement key padlock was installed which uses the same key as that of Pam's Lane Vehicle Entrance padlock. Keys are available from Cathy Page at £15 each.
- 2. Overgrown grass at the bottom of plot number 13a and on the corner of BT Exchange Action: Clerk to ask contractor to strim/mow both areas leaving the young walnut tree and fruit bushes.
- 3. Sign for plot 7a has broken into two and needs gluing.

Action: Clerk to glue.
