

Proposed Lighting Scheme for Public Bridlepath 33 Budgens to Wren Close

Scheme:

- To supply and install 8 no raise and lowering type street lighting columns associated cables and trenching
- Use of LED lights with directional features to minimise light spill into gardens. The lights will turn on at dusk, reduce by 25% at 11pm and stay on until 6am.
- The site was identified and supports HCC's Policies and Strategies regarding Sustainability (climate change emergency reduced carbon and energy), Place and Movement (active travel to encourage walking and cycling and safe routes to schools). The scheme can be constructed in this financial year 22/23 if successful.
- Scheme proposed by Graham Baggott, Ducreux Limited. Ducreux Limited act as HCC's technical advisors in respect of electrically powered highway assets and our project sponsor is Peter Simpson Senior Asset Manager & Team Leader, Highways Operations, Environment & Transport, Hertfordshire County Council
- Informal discussions with users of the route when on site indicates support for such a lighting scheme.

Funding:

Total cost of the lighting scheme £26,044.32 to be covered by

1. North Herts Section 106 relating to Probyn House, land between Lloyd Way and Coopers Close, Kimpton. District ref. 13/00959/1 £16,925.00
2. County Cllr R Thake, Locality Fund £9,120
