

Bench Working Party Report

Parish Council

The Xmas market banners were erected around the village and two at Wheathampstead and were then taken down, the Xmas lights were put up and taken down. The marquee on The Green for the Xmas market was erected and taken down, the tables were set out in the church for the Xmas market stalls. Much other work was done to help the Christmas market. Siding out continued relentlessly, including sweeping up leaves and removing the gravel from the pavements opposite the bottom of Luton Road. The Rec gate was adjusted to make the shoot bolt work smoothly. At Peters Green the footpath post near the village hall was re-erected. The salt bins were filled up (twice). The broken dog poo bin at Parkfield Rec car was replaced with the refurbished one that had broken previously. The newly broken one was taken away to be refurbished. The poo bin at the Hitchin Road end of the Parkfield Car park approach road was reset, level, on the fence. Carina please note these products are not fit for purpose. Four bags of twigs were taken from the Upper Green to the hedge at the top of the Rec.

Community

The big display board at The Boot was painted red for the Kimpton Players to use to advertise their next production. A new play tower at the Pre School was assembled and erected (4 people for 6 hours!). The Players Music Hall banners were placed at each end of the village.

Church and Churchyard

The book swap shelves were re-sited at the rear of the church.

Memorial Hall

Many small maintenance jobs were carried out in the hall, including replacing some exterior lamps, fitting 3 new taps in the bar area, cleared leaves from the grass areas and the car park. The roof marquee lining was erected several times. The water heater was de-scaled. Two new wheels were fitted to the chair trolleys.
