

Why Make The Green Into A Meadow?

Journey From Green To Meadow

Starting in September, cut the new meadow area very short and then rake to the point that 50% soil is visible. The ground is then ready to sow the wildflower seeds which have been sourced as locally as possible, and then the transformation can begin.

The transition from green to meadow will take time, but each year we can enjoy the exciting developments as the meadow becomes more established and the variety of flowers and grasses increases each year.

On Going Maintenance

- ✚ The seating areas and pathways will be regularly mowed with the cuttings collected to mimic a “grazing effect”.*
- ✚ The meadow areas of flowers and grasses will be mowed once or twice a year, again with all cuttings raked and collected.*
- ✚ Dominant plants such as nettles and brambles will be removed as necessary.*
