Nature of activity of Organisation and how it benefits the residents of Kimpton, Peter's Green and/or Blackmore End:

Kimpton Preschool is the village's only preschool provider providing an essential early years setting for 2-4 year old children in the local area.

Membership number, if relevant, and % of those living in the parish: 100% of children are within the parish

Purpose for which grant will be used:

Kimpton Preschool has a low intake of new children this year. We are required by our landlords (HCC) to undertake all maintenance and preservation of the building in addition to updating equipment and facilities for the benefit of staff and children. This is funded from session fees which are predominantly from council funded children (therefore running at a loss for each child present) In addition we run fundraising events (we raised £2400 through a party in January and will run another one in December 2023. We require around £5000 annually to maintain the preschool and achieve all its goals

Amount of grant requested: £ 2000-2500

Total cost of project: 2000-2500

Please give details of grants applied for or received from other bodies: May Festival provide us with around £800 per year – in 2023 they funded a new climbing frame

The committee and staff are hugely committed to the success of the Preschool and we do all we can to ensure that each and every child has the most successful possible start to their learning journey. The low number of children will hopefully lessen with the new building in the village and surrounding area so hope that in future years we will be able to announce much more exciting things for the Parish Council to consider supporting (ideally replacing the aging astroturf in the garden area which has been quoted at £5000) – but for now we must be pragmatic and are hugely appreciative for Parish Council support
