Currently we're focusing on improving local facilities through our Kimpton Pavilion Refurbishment Project, getting people together to have fun by organising Kimpton Christmas Market and providing financial support for numerous community projects and to local organisations. We represent the views of the community on matters such as planning to North Herts Council, Highways and Rights of Way to Hertfordshire County Council and crime prevention to the police.
