There is limited transition from family housing to 1- or 2-bedroom properties by residents being able to downsize when they are elderly. There is an ageing population in the parish creating a demographic that is echoed across Hertfordshire. Housing developments in Codicote may generate school pupils for Kimpton. Has the council considered a 5-year strategy?
