Please see attached. In relation to last year, the printing cost (£102.38) was after the grant from the Council. The actual total cost was around £310. Last year we gave out programmes at the school, but are not planning to do that this year as the cost is not justified by the number of children's entries. The 2022 profit was high because we were not charged for the Memorial Hall and we just had a huge show (in terms of entries and scale generally), which we put down to a kind of post-Covid sigh of relief.

How do you intend to maintain the financial viability of the organisations?

By operating the Autumn Show each year on a break-even/small profit basis. We are not trying to generate profits on the scale of the May Festival. We regard the Show as an inherently worthwhile event in itself, but if we can help the food table or other village needs on a modest basis, that's all to the good.
